Capital Clean Energy Carriers Corp. (NASDAQ: CCEC), an International shipping company, is one of the world's leading platforms of gas carriage solutions with a focus on the energy transition. CCEC currently owns 20 high specification vessels, including 12 latest generation LNG carriers (LNG/Cs) and eight legacy Neo-Panamax container vessels. In addition, CCEC has agreed to acquire six additional latest generation LNG/Cs, six dual fuel medium gas carriers and four handy liquid CO2/multi gas carriers, to be delivered between the first quarter of 2026 and the third quarter of 2027.

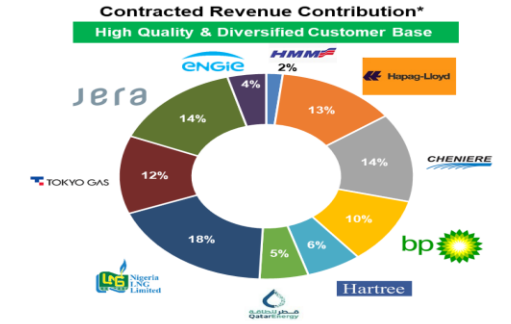
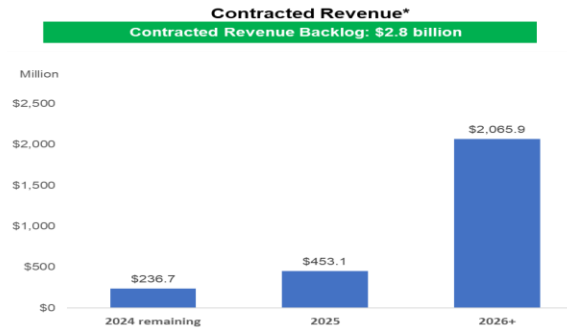
New era for company with corporate conversion and name change – August 2024

Name Change and Corporate Conversion

- Capital Product Partners L.P. was renamed **Capital Clean Energy Carriers Corp. effective August 26 2024 which emphasizes our strategic pivot** to the LNG and energy transition business.
- Capital Clean Energy Carriers Corp is a Marshall Islands corporation and has adopted enhanced standards of corporate governance and transparency to investors.

Transparent governance structure & alignment among all shareholders to catalyze value creation

- Trading liquidity** expected to increase over time and improve group access to capital markets to fund growth
- Transition** from MLP to growth-oriented corporate structure expected to **broaden investor universe and increase appeal to institutional investors**
- Improved governance rights** for unaffiliated shareholders with elimination of the General Partner and Incentive Distribution Rights ("IDRs"), **aligning all shareholder interests**
- Eight-member **Board, majority independent**, with one-year terms

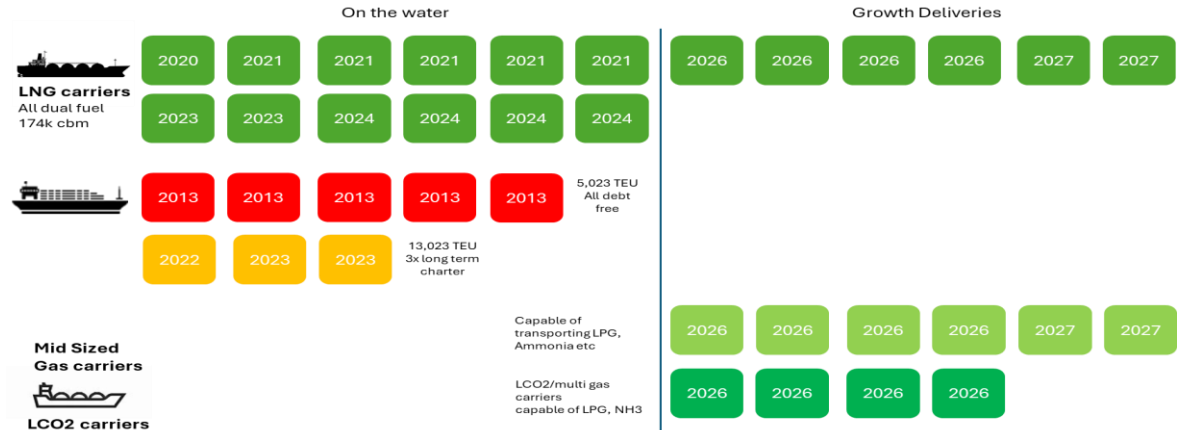

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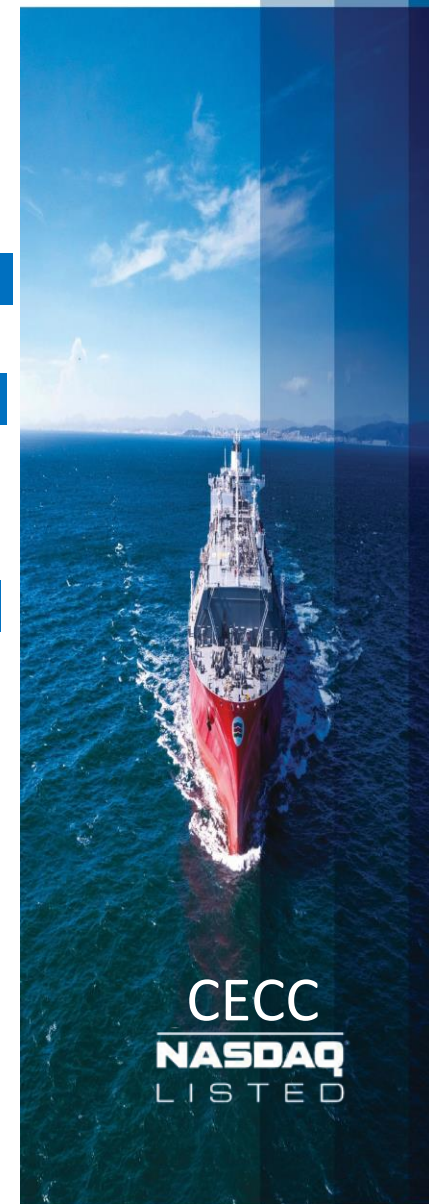
